Revised Draft Assignment

Each student will be expected to submit a revision of a graded draft once per semester. These revisions will be assigned on a case-by-case basis after a graded assignment has been returned. Students must submit a hardcopy of the revised draft with the graded draft of the previous version by the agreed upon date. The revised draft must also be submitted to Turnitin.com under the "Revised Draft Assignment."

Although all students will be encouraged to rework each assignment based on the instructor's comments, only one revision will be submitted for a grade.

The revised draft should reflect a holistic reworking of the failings of the graded draft. Simply fixing the errors marked by the instructor does not qualify. Unless otherwise noted, students must make an appointment with Mr. Francis for a 10-20 minute meeting before submitting this assignment. In cases in which this is prohibited by our respective schedules, a confirmed visit to the Writing Center may be substituted (this does not mean that other students are prohibited from visiting the Writing Center).

Students needing to borrow a copy of the text(s) should visit a library or see Mr. Francis. Do not solicit a friend or Room 601 to obtain a copy. It is preferred that you use the same edition and translation (when applicable) of the text(s).

The revised draft is worth approximately 5% of your final grade. The revised draft will be assessed based on improvements in writing mechanics, structure, and development of ideas. Any student who fails to submit an assigned revision will lose 5 points from the third marking period grade.

Please print a copy of this document to help manage the logistics of your revised draft. It should be stapled as a coversheet to your revised draft before submitting it.
